About Dog Scouts of America (DSA)

About the Hike-a-Thon

- Choose your commitment. You can choose a mileage for a single day-hike, or you can set a goal of a total mileage to be completed during the entire month. Write this on your pledge form. (Keep safety in mind when choosing!)
- Register. Register online at www.FirstGiving.com/dogscouts.

or use the form below to register. There is no registration fee. Your dog does not need to be a Dog Scout to participate, in fact you can be a part of the Hike A Thon without a dog if you are somehow between dogs. You could choose to dedicate your miles in memory of a beloved dog who has crossed the Rainbow Bridge.

- Collect pledges. Ask friends and family if they would like to support your fundraising efforts. You can use the attached pledge form for in-person fundraising, and you can also create a FirstGiving page for online fundraising.
- Complete your commitment.
- Send in pledges. Pledges collected online via FirstGiving will automatically go to DSA. For other pledges, send in the attached pledge form with checks payable to DSA.
- Patches and Prizes. A Hike-a-Thon patch will be awarded to participants who raise \$50 or greater in pledges; DSA logo bag & water bottle for those who raise at least \$200; and \$50 or



\$100 gift certificates for raising \$500 or \$1,000.

Using FirstGiving to register / collect pledges

- Go To: www.firstgiving.com/dogscouts. You can register online, as well as create a personalized fundraising page. (Using FirstGiving is OPTIONAL, but it's a great way to raise funds and is EASY to use!) be sure to enter your team as "DSA Troop ___" if you are on a troop team.
- Spread the Word: You can share your fundraising page with friends and family all over the world via e-mail, Facebook, Twitter, etc.
- Online donations. People click on the link to your page, then use credit cards to donate online.
- Type in donations you collect in person. You can also enter onto your FirstGiving page any pledge amounts you collect in person. If you have a FirstGiving page, please ensure you enter all of your donations, so that we can take advantage of tracking our progress real-time!
