

## **Dog Scouts of America**

### **Activity check-off sheet**

#### **Frisbee Freestyle:**

All behaviors must have been taught or re-taught to the dog (preferably using a new cue), using only positive reward based methods.

- Handler can throw the frisbee from under leg**
- Handler can throw the frisbee behind his/her back**
- Handler can throw the frisbee upside-down**
- Handler can throw the frisbee from side (sidearm throw)**
- Handler can throw the frisbee from side (overhand wrist flip)**
- Handler can throw a vertical pop (two handed)**
- Handler can pop the frisbee to the dog**
- Handler can throw the frisbee backwards between his/her legs**
- Dog will drop the frisbee to go for another when cued**
- Dog will catch two or more consecutive frisbees**
- Handler can throw to cause the dog to flip to the side**
- Dog will flip to the side to catch the frisbee**
- Handler can throw consecutive flips**
- Handler can throw a butterfly**
- Handler can choreograph a routine and set it to music**
- Handler and dog perform a 1 minute or longer routine incorporating as many of the above moves as possible, set to music and performed for an audience (any of the above moves not included in the routine can be shown separately.)**
