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| Dog can go to the opposite side of the ball and assume a stationary position (sit, stand or |
| down) for 5 count without ball contact |
| Dog understands how to reposition himself opposite the handler (keeping the ball between |
| the dog and handler) as the handler moves around the ball |
| Dog can start near the handler, 15' from the ball, and get to the stationary position behind |
| the ball facing the handler (can use a target) |
| Dog can push one ball directly to the handler from 10' away. Handler may not step toward |
| the dog across the goal line, but may move laterally 5' each direction from the start position |
| (10' wide goal, handler starts in the center) Handler needs to be able to capture the ball |
| without leaving the designated goal area. |
| Handler recognizes the signs that their dog is getting over stimulated, understands how to |
