## **Land Retrieves:**

_		Dog will retrieve wing-covered dummy, in short grass on level ground, with shot fired
_		Dog comes to handler on whistle only cue from a sit-stay
_		Dog will perform a blind retrieve thrown or dropped at least 50 feet away (handler and dog must turn their backs while the dummy is thrown or placed)
_		Dog will do a single retrieve of a wing-covered dummy, thrown 50 to 100' away from the dog in moderate cover, with a shot fired about 50' away from the dog. Dog must be steady to shot.
