Activity check-off sheet

Flyball:

Dog sport in which a team of 4 dogs races against another team of 4 dogs in a relay race style.

All behaviors must have been taught or re-taught to the dog (preferably using a new cue), using only positive reward based methods.

- runs past finish line to "focus" (motivator)
- one jump & past finish
- two jumps & past finish line
- three jumps & past finish line
- four jumps & past finish line
- box, turn and four jumps OR ball off ground & four jumps
- 4th jump, ball & 4 jumps back
- 3rd & 4th jumps, ball & 4 jumps back
- 2nd, 3rd & 4th jumps, ball & 4 jumps back
- all 4 jumps down, ball, & 4 jumps back
- all of the above with no barriers
- all of the above with a pedal hit

- all of the above passing with the dog running before you (safety pass)**
- all of the above with the dog running after you (safety pass)**

- Individual dog can do all 4 jumps to the box, hit the box, catch the ball and complete the 4 jumps back holding the ball**
