Criteria for Badges Guidelines for Evaluators

Frisbee Badge

This badge shows that the handler has taught his or her dog to run out, catch a Frisbee disk, and retrieve it quickly, as in a timed competition.

Dog Requirements: Dog must be able to catch at least some Frisbees from 10 yards out (to receive points), either in the air or on the ground (preferably in the air).

Handler Requirements: Handler understands the scoring system for competition. Handler understands safety concerns for this sport. Handler can throw a Frisbee, and keep it aloft at a distance at which his dog can catch it for points.

Equipment Needed: Competition Frisbees, Measuring Tape (or some other way of telling if the handler has thrown the Frisbee 10 yards or more). If the Evaluator checks out the team at a frisbee competition, he or she does not need to provide any equipment. Parent can provide their own Frisbee, provided it is an acceptable competition model.

Allowable:

Smaller, regulation frisbee disk for small dogs. Any time allotment the Evaluator feels adequate.

Not Allowable:

Non-regulation Frisbee disks

Pinch-throwers, unless the handler has a disability. This is a team activity—both you and your dog earn the badge together. (Being Frisbee challenged is not a disability)
