

Dog Scouts of America Merit Badge Check-Off Sheet

Backpacking

Items **bolded** below are requirements that must be demonstrated to the Evaluator. Non-bolded items are training steps that may be introduced in class and are helpful for achieving the requirements. All behaviors must have been taught or re-taught to the dog (preferably using a new cue), using only positive reward-based methods.

Dog is comfortable with the backpack and will allow the empty pack to be draped across his shoulders
Dog will allow the empty backpack to be strapped on and adjusted and will walk on a loose leash while wearing the empty pack
Dog will wear the backpack containing a light load
Dog will wear the backpack containing a heavier load, including all required items
Handler can choose a pack appropriate for the dog, can put the pack on the dog and adjust it, and can distribute the weight of the pack evenly
Dog will carry the backpack containing all of the required items for a hike of at least 3 miles; dog does not have to heel while hiking but must maintain a loose leash
Dog may not chase wildlife while hiking
Dog demonstrates a quick response to a 'leave it' cue
Dog demonstrates that he can safely meet a friendly stranger while hiking
Handler demonstrates responsible dog ownership on the trail and cleans up after the dog by bagging and packing out the dog's waste and disposing of it properly
Handler always carries at least 3 clean up bags when hiking
Handler demonstrates an understanding of and always follows the 'leave no trace' principles
Handler must demonstrate that he/she is able to identify and locate poison ivy and/or other dangerous plants; handler can identify other dangers that might be encountered while hiking in his/her area
Handler must name, from memory, the 12 items required to be carried in the dog's pack without looking at a list or in the pack
Handler and dog must complete a minimum of 6 miles of hiking, including the 3-mile hike described above; dog must wear the pack containing all of the required items while hiking
