

Dog Scouts of America Merit Badge Check-Off Sheet

All Dog Band

Items **bolded** below are requirements that must be demonstrated to the Evaluator. Non-bolded items are training steps that may be introduced in class and are helpful for achieving the requirements. All behaviors must have been taught or re-taught to the dog (preferably using a new cue), using only positive reward-based methods.

Dog has earned the Art of Shaping badge
Handler shapes a new behavior for playing an instrument such as a nose push for playing a piano, a head shake for a shake instrument like a tambourine or maracas, or any behavior that does not resemble painting or use the dog's foot
Handler approaches the teaching process methodically and requiring increasing difficulty until the dog will produce and maintain the instrument playing behavior
Handler avoids chanting "playplayplay" to the dog before he understands the cue
Handler puts the instrument playing behavior on cue, either a verbal cue or hand signal by adding the cue just before the behavior occurs
Handler is careful with the equipment, does not damage it or allow the dog to damage it, and returns it to the location where it is stored when done
Dog participates in an "All Dog Band" performance and demonstrates the instrument playing behavior while other dogs are also playing instruments
Dog will perform the behavior in at least 2 different locations in addition to the location of the "All Dog Band" performance
